RULES AND INFORMATION SHEET

Our annual Talent Show will be Friday, March 17, 2017. Every student is invited to participate! Every child will receive a trophy. The show always promises to be great entertainment and fun for the entire family. Please make plans to join us even if your child does not participate.

*******ADMISSION IS \$6.00 FOR EVERYONE OVER AGE 4*******

The following rules MUST be followed in order to perform – NO EXCEPTIONS!

REGISTRATION & FEES:

- ▢ Every performer must complete a registration form via tinyurl.com/2017ebreg and submit a NON-REFUNDABLE \$5.00 cash fee (sent to school in envelope clearly marked Talent Show/Child's name) by **February 17, 2017**. A google form will be used for registration this year. You should find this to be quick and convenient; however, if you are unable to complete registration online, printed forms will be available in the office upon request.
- ▢ You may enter artwork and perform, but you may only perform in one act. A trophy will be given for each.
- ▢ To perform and enter artwork, the fee is \$10.00 cash.
- ▢ Completion of the online form indicates acknowledgement that the rules will be followed.
- ▢ **GROUPS:** Upon registration, group acts must have a specific "Act Name" that will be included on the form. Forms are completed individually and The "Act Name" will automatically place the student into the correct group in our system, therefore the Act Name needs to be exact.
- ▢ The name of song/music and version to be used must be listed on form. Lyrics will be reviewed and you will be contacted if necessary.
- ▢ **5TH GRADERS:** They may perform in 2 acts but one must be the 5th grade finale. Participants must submit \$5.00 cash fee per act.
- ▢ **Forms must be completed and registration fee submitted NO later than Friday February 17, 2017.**

No student may perform without a submitted form. NO ENTRIES AFTER THIS DATE!!!!

PERFORMANCES:

- ☐ All performances – dance moves, lyrics, costumes, etc. – are to be age appropriate. Our children are the audience.
- ☐ Performances are limited to three (3) minutes!!! Make sure to time your act.
- ☐ You may sing (LIP-SYNCHING IS NOT ALLOWED), dance, play an instrument, perform a skit, gymnastics, cheerleading, baton, any form of karate, etc. or you can enter any artwork.

MUSIC:

- ☐ Recorded music must be on a CD.
- ☐ CD must be a copy of only three (3) minutes to be performed.
- ☐ CD must be in case labeled with student's name, act, teacher and song title.

DRESS REHEARSAL: MARCH 16th, 2017

- ☐ Dress rehearsal is mandatory!! To perform, you must attend & wear outfit that will be worn in show.
- ☐ Bring your CD to school the morning of the rehearsal to be collected by each homeroom teacher.
- ☐ CD's will be returned to homerooms on Monday after the show.
- ☐ CD's must be in a case labeled with student's name, act, teacher and song title.
- ☐ Rehearsal times will be from 4 to 7 p.m. A rehearsal schedule will be sent home the week of the show and will be in shifts according to grade level – beginning with kindergarten.
- ☐ If your child is in the show and does not receive a rehearsal time, contact Melissa Reynolds (256-553-9882)

STAGE PROPS AND COSTUMES:

- ☐ Any prop used can be brought to the GCHS auditorium from 4 to 7 p.m. the day of the rehearsal and left backstage until after the show.
- ☐ Props HAVE to be removed from the auditorium at the end of the show.
- ☐ If props are large or require special knowledge to set up, please have someone ready to place the prop on stage and remove it after the student's performance.
- ☐ There can be NO tape, confetti, sparkle spray, glitter, or hay used during performance, placed on costumes, or used on stage props.

ART:

- ☐ Artwork will be on display in the lobby of the auditorium during the show.
- ☐ All artwork must be clearly marked with student's name, grade, and teacher.
- ☐ **Bring your artwork to GCHS auditorium between 4 – 7 p.m. on the day of the rehearsal.** A volunteer will be there to take it.
- ☐ Please pick up your artwork from the lobby after the show.
- ☐ Students submitting artwork will sit with their parents during show and called to stage to be recognized during intermission.
